

PROM – Summer schools – recruitment 2025/2026 – 3rd round

Basic information

As part of the PROM project - Short-term Academic Exchange (No. BPI/PRO/2025/1/00047), two summer schools for students and doctoral candidates from foreign universities are planned. This is an announcement of the third recruitment round.

Project goals: Schools will enable the real formation of a new generation of social leaders capable of critical thinking, intercultural cooperation, and initiating responsible changes in their communities in accordance with democratic values.

Schedule: 9 days (2 travel days and 7 core activities days).

Number of participants: 1 student

Source of funding: Project co-financed by the European Funds for Social Development under the NAWA program.

Summer school description:

- The school (**Summer School for the Promotion of Democratic Values, University of Gdańsk, (15th – 23th of August 2026)**) will focus on promoting democratic values in academia and society. Participants will take part in lectures, seminars, panel discussions, and study visits to public institutions, learning about the mechanisms of social participation, the functioning of local democracy, and the importance of civic engagement. Participants' reflections will be captured in multimedia format, including video presentations and team projects, created under the supervision of specialists as part of a separate training module.

Participation requirements:

The project can accommodate:

- **1 participant from country group no. 2**, ie. Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Moldova, Germany, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Ukraine, Hungary.

Furthermore, recruitment may be undertaken only by a person with a student status (bachelors, masters or uniform master's studies) or with a current doctoral student status on the day of joining the recruitment process and throughout the entire mobility period, as well as declaring ability to use of English at a level not lower than B2.

Applications:

The primary condition for joining the program is that the candidate submits an application via the electronic form.
